



## SCHOLARSHIP AWARD ANNOUNCEMENT. SCHOLARSHIPS NAMED AFTER “AR. A. SISSA” 2013 – 2022

7<sup>th</sup> edition a. y. 2019/2020

For the a. y. 2019/2020 Fondazione UniverMantova renews the scholarship award announcement for the allocation of 4 scholarships worth € 2.500 each. These are earmarked to young people who have a bachelor's degree and are enrolled in the Master's Degree “ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN AND HISTORY” in the framework of the architecture studies offered in Mantova Regional Campus by Politecnico di Milano, for them to complete their studies.

### PRELIMINARY REMARKS:

The available amounts come from the bequest of Cesare Sissa and Elisa Ghirardini Provasoli's family, in memory of Ar. Adolfo Sissa (1948 – 1976), a young, cheerful and knowledgeable man, with an outstanding artistic talent and an unprejudiced social spirit. These amounts were donated in order to encourage the most deserving students of the Architecture and Construction Engineering School who are willing to complete and deepen their studies in Architecture, with an economic contribution.

### PARTICIPATION CONDITIONS:

Participation applications to the award announcement can be forwarded by Italian and foreign citizens who have a bachelor's degree, are enrolled as regular students in the Master's Degree at Mantova Regional Campus of Politecnico di Milano for the a. y. 2019/2020, have presented a **degree dissertation on architectural design topics**, and comply with the following requirements:

- First year students: enrolment age of 23 or younger on 31/12 of the year referred to in the announcement, and bachelor's degree gained with a minimum mark of 95/110 or equivalent;
- Second year students enrolled in the Master's Degree in in “ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN AND HISTORY”: enrolment age of 24 or younger on 31/12 of the year referred to in the announcement, bachelor's degree gained with a minimum mark of 95/110, and with at least 40 academic credits achieved with a weighted grade point average of 24/30 or higher on this announcement's expiry date (October 4th 2019).

### TIME LIMITS AND PROCEDURES FOR APPLICATION:

The application form must be forwarded personally or sent via registered mail with proof of delivery, or scanned, signed and sent via email by means of a specific form by 5.00 PM of October 4th 2019 to the Student Secretary of Fondazione UniverMantova, via Scarsellini No. 2, including the following documentation:

- A paper and an electronic copy of the degree dissertation (it should be pointed out that the paper copy is necessary for a quicker consultation by the Panel of Judges and will be returned to the candidate after the winners' list is compiled);
- A certificate attesting the graduation average mark for the admission to the Bachelor's Degree examination or equivalent document;
- Bachelor's Degree Certificate attesting the list of completed examinations, the related academic credits and the final mark or equivalent documents;
- Certificate of enrolment to the Master's Degree provided with a list of the completed examinations with the related academic credits and the grade point average (for second year students only);
- Documentation on the abroad study and research activities.
- Curriculum vitae.

Fondazione UniverMantova will undertake all necessary actions in order to assess the truthfulness of the presented documentation.

Applications by students lacking the needed requirements will not be accepted.

The scholarship is incompatible with other scholarships offered by universities or other entities.



It should be clarified that the candidate must immediately return the obtained award, in case the forwarded documentation is found in non-compliance with all the obligations indicated in the announcement.

#### WINNERS' LIST WRITING AND PUBLICATION:

The evaluation of the collected applications will be carried out according to the assessment criteria the specifically appointed Panel of Judges defined in the Regulations (\*)

The related winners' list will be reported to those concerned at the latest on October 18<sup>th</sup> 2019.

#### SCHOLARSHIP ALLOCATION:

The payment of the amount is subject to the scholarship's acceptance and to the fulfilment of the given requirements for the entire duration of the year of reference, and will be made in three instalments with the following deadlines:

- October 31<sup>st</sup> 2019
- March 31<sup>st</sup> 2020
- October 31<sup>st</sup> 2020

#### TAXATION, SOCIAL SECURITY AND INSURANCE SYSTEM OF SCHOLARSHIPS:

Beneficiaries of scholarships "Ar. Adolfo Sissa" are subject to taxation on the incomes treated as salaries and wages, according to art. 50 section 1 letter c of Single Text 22/12/1986 n. 917 and following amendments and additions.

#### REPORT ON PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING:

All the data acquired from candidates will be registered by Fondazione UniverMantova and processed by its staff as well as by the Panel of Judges only to follow the Bylaws and comply with legal requirements. Data and references will be protected according to Law 196/2003 (Privacy Act) and will not be transmitted nor disseminated, except for the possibility for the institution to assess the truthfulness of the candidates' declarations.
